



Children's Rights to Play – Children develop a creative set of methods about children's rights!

We invite your child to creatively explore children's rights and to get creative themselves!

Children usually learn about their rights in a short lesson at school, if they learn about them at all. As a result, they may have a basic idea of their rights, but may not know how to claim or assert them. In "Children's Rights to Play", children will become experts on children's rights over the course of three years and learn how to playfully inform other children about them - empowering children to confidently stand up for their rights.

To achieve this, the children will independently develop a playful set of methods focused on children's rights. This set will be professionally produced so that children can play it with other children and engage with children's rights without adults.

The project "Children's Rights to Play" begins in February 2026 and ends in July 2028. Participation is free of charge, and the project takes place at various locations in Berlin. We offer supervised travel: children travel together with volunteer staff from their neighborhood to the meetings and are accompanied back home. We provide snacks, and on longer workshop days also lunch. The working language of the project is German.



Project timeline:

The project kick-off will take place on February 7 and 8, 2026. On these days, the child can get to know the project and the team and then decide whether they would like to register for the project. In addition, on February 8 we will attend a performance of "Our Time" (dt: "Unsere Zeit") by the GRIPS children's theatre club Rakete Jetzt together.

In 2026, we will meet with the children once a month on a weekend for two days to approach the topic of children's rights through creative workshops such as dance, circus, or photography. The children decide themselves what they would like to try.

The first date is already set: February 28 and March 1 at GRIPS Podewil.

In 2027, the children will take on creative responsibility themselves and develop creative set of methods on children's rights, which can be used, for example, in schools. Once the method set has been fully developed, we will celebrate with a big festival that we plan together with the children.

In 2028, we will travel together with the children to schools in Berlin to present and use the game.
